How much time do I need to allow for embarking and disembarking?

For air arrivals and departures into Barcelona it is recommended guests allow adequate time for transfer between the airport and pier, customs inspections and airport security checks. On the day of departure (**August 2**) flights should arrive no later than **3:30 pm** and on the day the ship returns (**August 9**) flights should depart after **10:00 am**.

Can I purchase transfers from the airport to the ship?

If you are arriving in the Barcelona airport on the day of sailing you may add transfers to the ship for \$60.00 per person each direction. These transfers are provided by Royal Caribbean Cruise Line and **must be added to your cruise booking by June 15**. Flight numbers and details are required for your reservations. Taxis run approximately 30 Euros (\$42 US) and are faster and less expensive. You are about 30 minutes away from the ship terminal. Most passengers in our group will take taxis.

When may I embark the ship?

The *m/s Voyager of the Seas* departs from port of Barcelona Moll Adossat at 7:00 pm. **Embarkation begins at approximately 12:00 pm**. Guests must be on board no later than 6:00 pm

Hotel Recommendations

For those arriving into Barcelona early or staying later after the cruise hotel options would be available on websites like www.hotels.com or www.kayak.com.

Making dining room reservations?

Due to our seminar times our entire group will be dining at 8:30 pm. All dining requests must be made in advance of sailing through Worldview Travel. **Table companion seating preferences must be made by June 30**. Upon check-in at the pier you will be given your table assignment. After the first night we will have open seating within our group tables, which will give you the flexibility to dine with a variety of people. For a buffet style restaurant you can try the Windjammer Cafe on Deck 11 which is complimentary and attire is casual.

Reservation-Only Dining Room

As a delicious alternative to the main dining room, you might consider the Portofino Restaurant. This elegant specialty restaurant is by reservation only. There is a \$25 per person charge for this experience. You can make your reservations online up to 4 days before your cruise begins by going to www.royalcaribbean.com/specialtyrestaurants

Can the Dining Room accommodate special diets?

Watching your salt, fat or sugar intake? Going Vegetarian? Advise us at the time of booking and we'll be happy to accommodate any special diets. Gluten-free or special medical diets must be pre-ordered a minimum of 60 days prior to sailing. Contact Worldview Travel for these special requests.

May I bring my own liquor On-Board?

No alcohol may be brought onboard for consumption.

We're bringing the kids; any special activities for them?

Absolutely! Youth activities are directed and organized by a special staff of youth counselors. Fully supervised programs for children 3 (must be potty trained) to 17 are available. For children ages 3-6 activities include theme parties, treasure hunts and T-shirt decorating. Ages 7-9, relay races, team trivia and fitness activities, ages 10-12, pool Olympics, scavenger hunts and karaoke and for teens 13-17, pool and pizza parties, video games, disco, movies and more.

When can I reserve my shore excursions?

A wide variety of shore excursions are offered by the cruise line in our various exciting ports of call. You can view and reserve excursions six months in advance either online at www.royalcaribbean.com or for assistance email the Shore Excursion desk at shorex@rccl.com before sailing, or make your arrangements when you board your ship – based upon availability. **Pre-booking is highly recommended and is cut off 10 days prior to sailing.**

Stateroom Amenities

All staterooms include: full length mirrors, vanity, safe, telephone, hairdryers, refrigerators, multi-channel music system, and remote-controlled color TV. Staterooms are equipped with only North American standard 110 volt and adapters are required for European Standard 220 volt appliances.

What's included in our Cruise Price?

- All meals, including room service, except in the alternate restaurant, Portofino *Restaurant*
- Most entertainment & activities onboard
- The full seminar program and private events with Debbie Ford

What's not included in the price?

- Air Transportation cost or transfers to the ship
- Shore excursions in the various ports
- On board: sodas, alcoholic beverages and bottled water, telephone calls or internet access service, spa treatments, laundry or dry cleaning, photographs and casino gambling.

Cruise Attire

Casual wear will be appropriate for days onboard. For evening wear, count on three basic types of attire.

- Casual: dresses, or slacks & blouse for women; sport shirts & trousers for men
- Formal: cocktail dresses for women; suits & ties, or tuxedos for men
- Smart Casual: dresses or pantsuits for women" jackets for me.

There are two formal nights, one smart casual, and the rest casual.

No self service laundry and ironing facilities are available. Full laundry services are available for a fee.

Ship Contact Information?

Your final documentation packet will contain detailed information including the phone number for your ship and Email address. The Internet Café is available for sending and receiving emails. Wireless connections are available from a number of areas onboard for those who would like to use their own computers – but not in the staterooms. Charges of approximately 55 cents per minute will apply for this service and will be posted to your ship board account. When using the Internet Cafe' you will be able to buy different minute packages onboard and is open 24 hours a day with ample computers available

Weather

Expected temperatures range from a low of 65° F (night) to a high of 85° F (day). It is advisable to check the internet for up-to-date weather conditions prior to sailing.
